1547. Approve and Sign Minutes of Annual Parish Council Meeting – 10th July 2014:

Minor amendments were agreed and the minutes signed as a correct record. *Proposed: Geoffrey Woollard. Seconded: Steve Kent-Phillips. Agreed unanimously.*

1548. Reports:

CCC Matters: Cllr David Brown reported to the meeting.

GW asked DB if the proposed new Secondary School at Hampton Gardens was to be run by the Council. *DB replied that no new schools are run by councils*.

SG said that children who moved during the school holidays were not able to start school at the beginning of term and asked DB if they could be fined. *DB to follow up and report back*.

ECDC Matters: Cllr Allen Alderson reported to the meeting.

Ely Southern By-Pass: CCC passed the planning application for this scheme at their Planning Committee Meeting on 8/9/14.

Ely Country Park: This has recently been awarded the 'Green Flag' status. It is a leisure facility that is growing in popularity.

SKP asked for clarification on a 'Green Flag' award. AA to provide full details at next meeting.

Planning-Ordnance Survey Maps. PL discussed this further with AA.

1549. Matters Arising from Previous Minutes (for information only):

Min.ref.1541: The Pound: The Clerk reported that Martin Mead had looked at the Pound and the reoccurring problem of weed growth and said he would carry out work to rectify.

Min.ref.1520: Passing Place, Station Road: The Clerk told the meeting that the work had been completed.

Min.ref.1538: Clerk' contract: SKP asked if this had been signed. Clerk said she would follow up with Chairman.

GW asked that for item 8 of the agenda to be brought forward to include DB in discussions. This was agreed.

1550. <u>Local Highway Improvement Initiative 2015/16 – Report on Meeting with CCC</u> Highways:

GW reported on meeting held on the 4/8/14 with CCC Officers Matthew Picking and Joshua Rutherford. PH also attended. Summary:-

- It was explained to MP/JR major and on-going concerns with regard to the traffic on and along Mill Hill; safety of pedestrians and general speed of much of the through traffic.
- Advice was asked of MP/JR on possible measures to help with the above. MP/JR said they were willing to consider:
- Reducing the speed limit from 40 to 30mph.
- Narrow islands, possibly 3, along Mill Hill. Less costly, probably under £10,000.
- Roundabout at the junction of Cage, Hill, Mill Hill and Heath Road. It was suggested this might cost as little as £30,000 £40,000 or could cost a lot more. Following a review of costs after the meeting, MP sent an email to the Clerk with a revised cost of £60.000 as it was considered that a full roundabout would be needed at this junction.

GW/PH explained that the Parish Council possessed the sum of £10,000 to be used only for traffic calming measures on or relating to Mill Hill and that subject to PC approval, all or some of this sum could be contributed to the cost of such measures.

Follow further discussion David Almond proposed pursuing the feasibility of a roundabout at the junction of Mill Hill/Heath Road/Cage Hill. Geoffrey Woollard seconded. All agreed.

Steve Kent Phillips proposed a contribution to project of at least 10% and up to £10,000. Paul Latchford seconded. All agreed.

The Clerk brought to councillors' attention the close date for LHI bid applications (12/9). DB advised the Clerk to confirm with CCC the Parish Council's intention to submit an application and follow up with completed details as soon as possible. *GW thanked DB for his input and support*.

Cllrs David Brown and Allen Alderson left the meeting at 8.25pm

1553. Review of Parish Council Insurance:

The insurance schedule was reviewed against the updated register of assets and submitted to insurers. Insurers noted the high increase in cover for The Pound and amended this to be included under 'Buildings Cover' as the premium was significantly reduced, i.e., the premiums for The Pound if covered for a sum insured of £10,000 under the building section would be £27.13 (including ipt and commission), the excess applying to this section of the policy is £100 for theft or accidental damage, £250 for

every other risk covered other than subsidence where the excess if £1,000. The premium for the Pound if covered for a sum insured under the all risks section would be £71.10 (including ipt and commission), the excess is £100 for each an every claim, but subsidence, landslip and ground heave are not covered.

The annual premium of £497.86 with a 3-year long term undertaking was agreed.

Proposed: Steve Kent-Phillips. Seconded: Paul Latchford. All agreed.

The question of insurance held by the VHMC for the Village Hall building was raised.

The Chair adjourned the meeting to allow member of the public to speak.

Meeting reconvened and PH noted the confirmation received from Alastair Everitt that the VHMC were responsible for building insurance cover. The Clerk/PL were asked to confirm the insurance details with the VHMC.
